- 1 Minutes from June meeting were read
- 2 Minutes were approved by HB and seconded by JO
- 3 Matters arising

- 4 Treasurer's Report

- 5 Report from Partners

- 6 Health Event
 - A great deal of discussion took place mostly positive but there were some disappointments. The PPG were pleased that Dr Haider was able to attend.

- 6B An email has been received from Dr Fitton asking if any member of the PPG would like to accompany him to a Seminar on Friday 13 July re Patient Access to Medical Records also to a Conference in November on the same subject.

- 7 GPNG
 - IE reported - The Bureau attended the GPNG meeting to explain that there are to be Patient Volunteers who will work with their 'Navigators' on a Buddy System to help people with the same medical problems. These volunteers will be known as 'Connectors'. It is hoped this will reduce some pressure for the GP's. Arrangements will be made for the Bureau to speak to our PPG.

 - Feedback was given on the GPNG Health Event held in May. Their next Health Event will be 13th October at Bradbury House Glossop 11am until 3pm.
- 8 Poems in the Waiting Room
 - The PPG agreed that this was a good idea, but did not want to incur any subscription costs to this project. AM had explored the possibility of local Poetry Groups producing poems for a leaflet, twice a year, with 5 – 6 Poems of no more than 20 lines. - it was stated that the George Street Clinic will not be a 'Walk in Centre' because it is not near to a hospital. This caused much concerned discussion at our PPG Meeting.
- Dr. G Wilkinson explained the reason Glossop was originally joined with Tameside, was because of the location of the nearest hospital.
